Friedrichshafen town – the origin of the town reaches back to the foundation of the Alemannic village, Alt-Buchhorn, in the 5th century.

King Friedrich of Württemberg united Buchhorn with the village and the Hofen monastery to "Stadt und Schloss (town and residence) Friedrichshafen" with altogether 750 inhabitants.



the first steamboat appeared on Lake Constance and, with the takeoff of the first Zeppelin airship on 2. July 1900 ushered in a new era which still influences our town to this very day.

the airship airport, Löwental, was opened and turned into a civilian airport in 1928.

the former railway ferry has also transported cars and lorries to Romanshorn.

the Hafenbahnhof (harbour station) was completed. After the Hindenburg disaster at Lakehurst on 6. May 1937, where 36 people died in the explosion of the LZ 129, the construction of further airships, as well as the flight operation of the zeppelins, was stopped.

**1943/1945** Friedrichshafen completely destroyed by air raids. After the war, the reconstruction period was influenced by companies, such as ZF Friedrichshafen, MTU Friedrichshafen, Zeppelin GmbH and the Dornier group.

the first IBO (international Lake Constance fair) followed.

the opening of the first "Interboot" (international boat fair) took place and, later, many other exhibitions and fairs which, since July 2002, have found a new home in the even more spacious new exhibition centre

the growing town of Friedrichshafen created a place for culture and exchange – "Graf-Zeppelin-Haus", the new culture and congress centre.

The school museum moves to the city centre – to the former "Villa Riß" at the Friedrichstrasse

Another top sight was opened in 1996, the "Zeppelin Museum" in the former Hafenbahnhof (harbour station), now presents the world's largest collection on the history of airship travel. 100 years after the first ascent of the "flying giants", the Zeppelin era was able to continue.

Since the year 2001, the Zeppelin NT has been cruising almost silently over the Lake Constance region.

The new media centre, k42, on the lakeside promenade was opened.

Friedrichshafen triumphed in Deutsche Telekom's T-City Competition and thus became Germany's first T-City.

Since the summer of 2009, the new Dornier Museum has become yet another highlight of the Friedrichshafen cultural scene for both locals and guests.

Friedrichshafen celebrated it's 200th anniversary. In addition, the Zeppelin Luftschiff Technik GmbH & Co. KG received the biggest order in the company's history: three new Zeppelin NTs for the Goodyear Tyre & Rubber Company.

various events were held to celebrate a special centenary: 100 years of seaplane construction in Friedrichshafen.



**2013** the town commemorated Count Ferdinand von Zeppelin's 175th birthday. 2014 the Dornier Museum celebrated a double Jubilee: the museum's fifth birthday and one hundred years of the Dornier company. 2015 various events accompanied the 100th anniversary of ZF Friedrichshafen.

the town commemorated Count Zeppelin's 100th death anniversary and celebrated Zeppelin NT's 20th anniversary of its inaugural flight.

150 years of the Lake Constance railway line and rail ferry – An anniversary celebration of the rail ferry trafficis celebrated on an international festival weekend around Lake Constance.

the Zeppelin Museum celebrated its twenty-fifth birthday.

At present, Friedrichshafen has approx. 62,000 inhabitants.

## City Tour



The Monument of Count Zeppelin "You just have to want and believe, then you will succeed." Is the inscription on the 13 meter high bronze column at the lake-side promenade. The Zeppelin monument honours Count Ferdinand von Zeppelin.

The Kultur-und Kongress Zentrum (Culture und Congress Centre) Graf-Zeppelin-Haus belongs to the most important places of cultural interest in the Lake Constance area. Highest level theatre, concerts and ballet performances, but also variety, jazz, pop and rock form part of the varied programme. www.gzh.de



The Schlosskirche (palace church) with it's two 55 m-high domed towers made from Rorschach sandstone is the landmark of Friedrichshafen. It was built by Christian Thumb from 1695 to 1701 and numbers among the famous Upper Swabian baroque buildings. Since 1812 it serves the Protestant community as a church. In 1944, it was partly destroyed by air raids, was then reconstructed from 1947 to 1951 and thereafter returned to the protestant community.

The Schloss (palace) was originally built as Weingarten Benedictine monastery by Michael Beer from Vorarlberg (Austria) in 1654. In 1802, it lost its status as a monastery during the process of secularisation. Under Wilhelm I of Württemberg, it was converted to a royal summer residence for the Württemberg Kings between 1824 and 1828. Today, it is a private residence and is closed to the public.

5 The Schlosssteg (palace pier) was built from sandstone as a strolling walkway on command by King Charles I. The pear was only used to greet guests from a distance.



Schulmuseum (school museum) Here you can let the stylus squeak... A visit to this museum is like going back to school. During your visit, you will find out how schools have developed and what classrooms looked like in 1850, 1900 and 1930. The entertaining tour displays school benches, pencil boxes, slates and much more to touch and discover. On the two-seater school bench, you can try out writing on slates. The lakeside promenade from the Rotach delta to the Schloss (palace), with a beautiful panoramic view over Lake Constance and the Alps, is one of the longest and most beautiful promenades on Lake Constance. This place on the lake with cozy sidewalk cafes and views of the sparkling lake is a feel-good place. From the port the ships of the white fleet, the catamaran and the ferry take you on a relaxed boat trip. At the gondola harbor pedal boat, rowboat and motorboat invite you to a spontaneous lake journey.

**Teppelin Brunnen (fountain).** The main figure, created in 1909, miraculously survived, virtually unscathed, the Second World War years in the demolished city. In 2000, the Zeppelin anniversary year, the fountain was re-erected as a reconstruction of the original.

 Buchhorn Brunnen (fountain). The fountain was designed and constructed by The married sculptors Barbara and Gernot Rumpf. It was inaugurated in 2001 and has been much loved by children ever since. In the centre of the fountain's basin stands a stylised tree, a beech. This tree, together with the horn, which lies at an angle in the basin, form the word "Buchhorn" ("Beechhorn"), the original name of the town of Friedrichshafen. Additional figures in the fountain depict the industrial development of the town.

The Nikolauskirche (Nikolaus church) was first mentioned as a chapel in 1325. The church was destroyed in 1944 and rebuilt from 1946 until 1949. The interior was renovated in 1986/89, and again in 2011.

1 1 Moleturm (viewpoint tower) on the pier. From the 22 m-high viewpoint L tower, you will have a unique panoramic view of the town with the palace church, the orchards in the background and a superb view of Lake Constance and the Swiss and Austrian Alps. A panoramic board, which was installed in 2010 on top of the viewpoint tower, offers a detailed view of the alpine mountain range across the lake. 🙆

Medienhaus k42 (media centre) The k42 is, without doubt, one of the most spectacular buildings on the shores of Lake Constance. The facade, entirely of glass, radiates transparency and openness. The highlight of the collection of buildings is the round, pebble-shaped event hall, "Der Kiesel", literally "The Pebble". Readings, theatre performances and concerts are held in the hall on a regular basis. &

In the listed Bauhaus building of the 75 minutes. In the listed Bauhaus building of the Zeppelin Museum, around 1,500 exhibits can be discovered on more than 4,000 m<sup>2</sup> of exhibition space, including the accessible passenger compartments of the airship LZ 129 Hindenburg in true-to-original replica. With almost 4,000 pieces of art, the museum has an art collection that gathers the greatest masters from southern Germany from the Middle Ages to modern times and draws a bridge to contemporary art. A special focus is on the works of Otto Dix, Max Ackermann and Willi Baumeister, which are presented in temporary exhibitions.

#### Family tour of the Zeppelin Museum

Start your Zeppelin journey with the museum case (3 €). In the exhibition you will find puzzles, photos and things to take home. The filled suitcase is a nice souvenir. No reservation required.

Dornier Museum Friedrichshafen – Anyone can be a pioneer – that is the main message of the Dornier Museum Friedrichshafen. Located close to the Friedrichshafen airport, it brings 100 years of fascinating air and space history to life. With architecture modelled on an airplane hangar, it houses 400 exhibits, including numerous original aircraft, one original helicopter and seven full-size exhibits from aerospace, in an area of 6,000 sgm. Authentic replicas, such as the first passenger aircraft of the Luft Hansa AG, the Dornier Merkur or the legendary flying boat, Dornier Wal N25, make the visit an unforgettable experience for technology enthusiasts, fans of history, aviation fans and families with children.

 $16\,$  from central station take bus line 5 to the <code>Zeppelin</code> <code>Hangar</code>. With the take-off of the first <code>Zeppelin</code> airship on 2nd July 1900, a new era started in Friedrichshafen which has had a lasting impact on the town. About a 100 years after the first "flying giants", the <code>Zeppelin</code> era continued with the <code>Zeppelin</code> NT which has been cruising almost silently over the <code>Lake</code> Constance region with its passengers since 2001. 12 different routes are on offer with a flight duration of between 30 minutes and 2 hours as well as guided tours for groups in the <code>Zeppelin</code> <code>Hangar</code>.

19 The Haldenberg chapel in Ailingen was built in 1892. In 1921, the chapel was carefully dismantled in the Reinachmühle and rebuilt on the Haldenberg. The hill, at an altitude of 479 m, is a popular place for excursions. In clear weather, there is a fabulous view over the lake on the Alps. This panoramic view is quite possibly one of the most beautiful in the whole city area.

The beautiful scenic path leads to the Haldenberg chapel. 





The idyllic path near the lake, overshadowed by tall trees, leads from Friedrichshafen to Fischbach. The Königsweg was the connecting path between the castle and the agricultural domain in Manzell. The path leads past the historic castle bridge to the Baroque Palace Church (Schlosskirche), the landmark of Friedrichshafen, and on to the scenic shoreline path.

#### Panoramaweg Ailingen – scenic path Ailingen

Starting from the town hall in Ailingen, via Unterlottenweiler and towards Horach, this path leads to the highest point of Friedrichshafen which offers a beautiful panoramic view over the lake and the Alps. Past the Höhlerösch, a protected wet meadow, you arrive at the Haldenbergkapelle (chapel), which is situated on top of the Haldenberg with probably the best view in Friedrichshafen. From the chapel, you walk past idyllic meadows down to the Fasanenweg, then on to the Haldenweg and the Gartenstraße, which leads you straight to the small park by the town hall.
