#### **Cathedral**

The Aachen Cathedral is one of the most famous examples of occidental architecture. It is the coronation church of more than 30 German kings, burial site of Charlemagne, major pilgrimage church and cathedral church of the Aachen diocese since 1930. In 1978 it was the first German building to be included in the UNESCO World Heritage list. A guided tour is therefore an essential part of any visit to Aachen and a 'must' for anyone who loves historic buildings and churches (see guided tours page 15).

## **Cathedral Treasury**

It houses sacral art treasures, among them some unique exhibits like the Cross of Lothair, the Bust of Charlemagne and the Persephone sarcophagus. These exhibits document the importance of the Cathedral of Aachen as a place of the medieval treasury. Individuals are invited to explore the treasury with a guided tour.

#### Town hall

At the beginning of the 14th century the Aachen citizenship built the gothic 'Rathaus' (town hall) on the foundation walls of the derelict palace building of Charlemagne. Between 936 1531 the banquets of the Aachen royal coronation ceremonies were held at this place. Today the monumental coronation hall still reminds of this time. There are also reproductions true to the originals of the imperial regalia, among them the imperial crowns, swords and the gospel books of sovereigns of the Middle Ages.

#### Couven Museum

Since 1958 the 'House Monheim' in the historical city centre of Aachen has been an exhibition place of particularly impressive upper middle-class cultivation of home décor. The rooms form a harmonious ensemble of various interior design styles from Rococo to the Biedermeier era. In a large room display cabinet a selection of magnificent silver utensils of the 18th century are e.g. presented. 

#### **Environmental zone Aachen**

As of February 2016, Aachen has an Environmental Zone. For the most part, the boundary of the Environmental Zone follows Aachen's outer ring road. In order to be able to drive your vehicle into Aachen's city centre, you now need a so-called 'Green Sticker'.


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
